GURU NANAK NISHKAM SEVAK JATHA (AREA 6)

The Gurdwara began on this site in 1978 with the purchase of two houses. In 1995 the building was re-developed to what we see today in the style of Sikh Architecture. The Nishkam Centre which is part of the Gurdwara, run an enormous number of projects including job clubs, a gym, health and well-being courses, they also run the primary school and nursery over the road, a pharmacy and law firm and the local Nishkam High School.

People attend for prayer, volunteering and partake in langar (free meals for all).

The external marble cladding was imported from a quarry in India and was paid for by the Sikh Community. The museum of the Sikh religion is also located in the Gurdwara.
