Birmingham Mailbox was previously home to the Royal Mail's sorting office and a railway goods yard. Today, it is home to a range of accommodation, offices, restaurants, retail stores and spaces including Castle Fine Art, the Everyman Cinema, Harvey Nichols, The Cube and Malmaison, in addition to the BBC studios, who will be relocating to Digbeth, after their lease ends in 2026.

The Worcester and Birmingham Canal links the Mailbox to the restaurants and entertainment districts of the Gas Street Basin, Brindley Place and Centenary Square. To the front of the building Grand Central, Victoria Square and the city centre are easily accessible by foot. More details can be found at Mailboxlife.com.
