I walked the A4540, the Middleway, Birmingham's Middle ring road, all the way around in one go. I started and finished at Belgrave Middleway by the junction with the A38 Bristol Road, walking in an anti-clockwise direction. The journey, which took just over four hours, at a distance of ten and a quarter miles, left me tired, elated and yet somewhat at odds with myself. This urban motorway is difficult to walk, the air is dirty, and I felt like I was constantly being repulsed by its polarised anti-pedestrian energies. And yet, despite it all, I came away from the Middleway feeling like I had connected with it, somehow.

Later, whilst I was editing and putting my images in order, this favourite old song came on my MP3 player. Suddenly the Middleway, and how I felt about my experience of walking it, began to make a curious sort of sense. It is alive, a dirty great beast of infrastructure that pulses with the energies and urgencies of modern urban life. It wraps around our great city like an asphalt Mobius strip, moving and turning, slipping and sliding, endlessly circulating the City. It's a livin' thing.

The song is called *Livin' Thing* by the Electric Light Orchestra, one of Birmingham's greatest ever bands. As I look back at these images this is the music I can't help but hear in my head, it transports me back to how I felt travelling along the Middleway. The lyrics to the song are reproduced here.

Sailin' away on the crest of a wave It's like magic Oh, rollin' and riding and slipping and sliding It's magic
