

THE HEBBLE TRAIL (AREA 2)

The part of the Hebble Trail I photographed runs from Phoebe Lane to Salterhebble Hill.

It is a former canal and was originally a continuation from the existing canal basin at Salterhebble. The canal was used to deliver goods by barge to Halifax and the Shaw Lodge Mills, which is situated near to the Shears Inn at Paris Gates.

The Red Beck runs parallel to the trail and has a weir. The trail features the hidden remains of the former canal, including an old bridge. It is now part of the national cycle way and is frequently used by commuters from nearby towns to Halifax.
